SCOPE

We are looking for the following types of hand sanitisers:

Non-alcohol

- With chlorhexidine 2%
- Without chlorhexidine

Alcohol-based

- With chlorhexidine 2%
- Without chlorhexidine
- ASTM E-1174

SPECIFICATIONS

At a minimum, all products must meet the following standards and testing requirements:

- AS/NZS ISO 9001:2008
- EN1276, prEN12054 and EN1500
- 21CFR 333.470
- ASTM E-1174

In addition to the minimum standards listed above, hand rubs that include a combination of non-alcohol and alcohol-based active ingredients, must have an alcohol concentration v/v of 70% to 80%.
