A Overview of Requirements

1 Purpose

a. The purpose of this Part 5 – Overview of Requirements, is to detail the scope sought under this Invitation to Qualify (ITQ).

2 Scope

- a. The scope of this ITQ includes:
 - (i) Medical Imaging Services for:
 - X-ray Radiography
 - Ultrasound Sonography
 - Computed Tomography CT
 - Magnetic Resonance Imaging MRI
 - Mamography
 - Angiography
 - Fluoroscopy
 - Nuclear Medicine
 - OPG/Cephalostat
 - Bone Densitometry
 - (ii) Medical Imaging Reporting Services for:
 - X-Ray Radiology Reporting
 - Ultrasound Reporting
 - Computed Tomography CT Reporting
 - Magnetic Resonance Imaging MRI Reporting
 - Mamography Reporting
 - OPG/Cephalostat Reporting
 - Bone Densitometry Reporting
- b. HPV reserves the right to expand or redefine the ITQ categories.
- c. Services currently covered or not covered by a HPV contract; however, falling within the scope of medical imaging services.
- Respondents shall note that this represents a brief overview of the proposed scope of work.
 More details will be included in any resultant and subsequent Invitation to Supply documentation.

3 Imaging Service Accreditation

a. Respondents must be qualified, credentialed and registered with the appropriate body at the location of service provision to provide medical imaging services.



- Respondents must have (and provide evidence of) the appropriate level of accreditation as prescribed by the Diagnostic Imaging Accreditation Scheme (DIAS), and The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists (RANZCR) Standards of Practice for Diagnostic and Interventional Radiology.
- c. Respondents must at all times be accredited under the DIAS.
- d. Respondents must comply with the Medicare Benefits Schedule requirements for private patients.

4 Quality Assurance

a. Respondents must have (and provide evidence of) the appropriate level of accreditation as prescribed by the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards (NSQHS).
