Transition clause

Add the following clause (or similar) into an appropriate place in the contract templates.

Transition clause

- a. If HealthShare Victoria enters into a contract in respect of Goods (or Services) which may apply to all Victorian public hospitals, denominational hospitals, private-operated hospitals and/or metropolitan health services (as listed in schedules 1, 2, 4 and 5 of the *Health Services Act 1988* (Vic) ("the State-wide contract"), then:
 - the Organisation may give notice to the Contractor that it wishes to purchase the Goods (or Services) on the terms and conditions of the HealthShare Victoria contract from a future specified date; and
 - ii. this Agreement shall end on the date specified by the Organisation; and
 - iii. the Contractor shall have no claim against the Organisation or its agents, employees, officers or servants in respect of this Agreement ending or the Organisation exercising its rights under this clause.
