Forcing someone to work against their will, often without pay and taking away their freedom, is modern slavery.

Having no personal identification or being unable to communicate freely can also be signs or 'flags' of modern slavery.



Did you know

- Over 1,900 people in Australia are victims of Modern Slavery.
- In Australia, only 1 in 5 modern slavery victims are detected.
- The Australian Federal Police (AFP) received more reports of Modern Slavery in 2023-24 than in any other financial year.

In healthcare, this can mean workers are overworked and unable to leave their job.
